

Shoeboxes and Drawstring bags

Shoeboxes

Sourcing your own shoebox is ideal but if you are finding this a challenge, Blythswood Care have sourced flatpack boxes that you can buy, wrap and fill for the Shoe Box Appeal.

Dimensions: length 38.5cm, width 16.5cm and height 12cm

Cost: 50p per box. This can be paid at shop or depot, or to staff member you receive them from.

Flat pack shoeboxes WILL ONLY be available from:

- Blythswood Care **Shops**. All shops will stock some boxes but you may need to order if wanting a large quantity.
- Blythswood Care **Depots and Sorts**, this includes Deephaven and Hillington and other SBA sort centres later in the year.
- Blythswood Care **Fundraising Managers** have a small quantity of flatpack boxes for you to purchase and fill. Please get in touch with:

Drawstring bags

It may be that this year you have difficulty in finding empty shoeboxes. If this is the case, please use a drawstring bag instead (like a gym bag). The maximum size should be 400mm x 300mm which can hold as much as an average sized shoebox. We also request that the drawstring bag *is not* plastic as the bag itself is a useful item to give to people.
